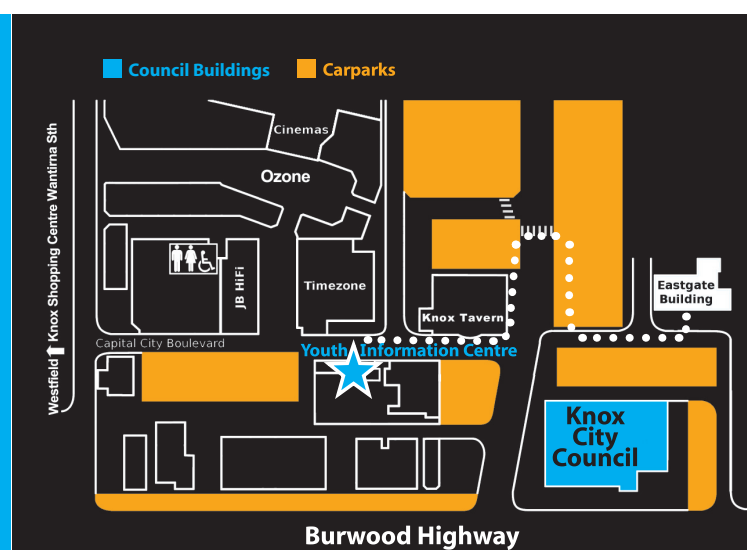

Knox City Council Youth Services provides information, referral, support and programs for young people aged 10-25 (and their families) who are living, working, studying or enjoying life in the City of Knox.

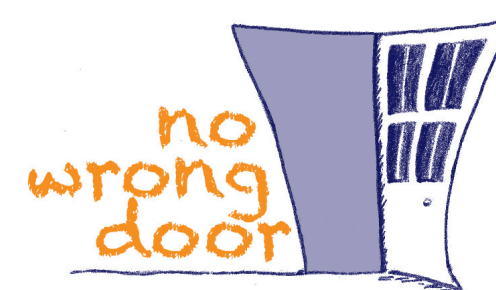
